Step 2: After submission, review the recommended additional Automotive scholarship opportunities that require or have preference for letters of recommendation from you.

Award	Amount	Require completed automotive scholarship application with essay and require or have preference of letters of recommendation.
Arthur T. Ross Scholarship	\$700	Completed application stating career goals, past achievements, and financial need. <u>Submit three (3) letters of recommendation</u> citing good citizenship.
Off Campus Military Scholarship	\$800	Enrolled full-time in the off-campus Automotive Technology program, completed a minimum of 12 semester hours in the major, 3.0 or greater GPA, demonstrate financial need. <u>Submit (2) two letters of recommendation</u> : one from a current faculty member or employer. The other may not be from a family member, SIUC employee, or student.
Automotive Parts and Service Association of IL and Ralph Silverman Memorial Scholarship	Four \$500	Completed application, legal resident of Illinois. <u>Preference is given to applicants with a letter of recommendation from a representative of an Illinois automotive aftermarket business.</u>
Keith & Alberta Humble Scholarship	Four \$1000	Preference shall be given to a student who: a) <u>submits two letters of recommendation which focus on commitment to a technical profession character and academic potential and capability</u> ; b) has financial need; c) is female or a member of a minority. Financial need of the student will be considered but will not be the single most important factor.

Award	Amount	Require completed automotive scholarship application with essay.
Ally – Automotive Student Scholarship	Five \$4700	To support underserved minority students and women pursuing education in Automotive Technology.
Edward Wright Memorial Scholarship	Four \$1000	SIU Automotive major.
Neil Swartz Scholarship	Two \$1500	SIU Automotive major. Demonstrated financial need, preference given to cumulative GPA 3.0 or greater, preference given to female applicant or if not eligible an underrepresented minority.
Dale Flener Scholarship	\$1000	SIU Automotive major in good standing; demonstrated scholastic ability; financial need; positive attitude; ability to work with peers; motivation to achieve and enthusiasm to learn. Preference given to a student from the Southern Illinois area.
Mossie Oak Automotive Technology Scholarship	\$1800	SIU Automotive major in good standing; demonstrates a positive attitude; ability to work with peers; motivation to achieve and enthusiasm to learn.
Boost Auto Parts	Two \$1000	SIU Automotive major in good standing; demonstrates a positive attitude; ability to work with peers; motivation to achieve and enthusiasm to learn.

Duncan and Wilma Lampman Scholarship	Two \$1000	SIU Automotive major who completed their first year of college at SIU in Automotive, 3.0 overall GPA or higher, 3.5 GPA or higher in automotive courses, preference for those displaying financial need.
Jim Krudl Scholarship	\$1000	Junior or Senior with SIU Automotive major.
Alumni Constituency Society Scholarship	\$1000	Must be relative of an SIU graduate with preference given to relatives of CASA CTC STC VTI or other succeeding colleges. Recipient must be majoring in Automotive and enrolled full-time for the semester of the award. First-time applicants will be given priority for awards but individuals may re-apply every semester of enrollment.
James E. White Scholarship	Three \$1000	Full-time SIU Automotive major in good standing who demonstrates a positive attitude, exceptional classroom attendance, and passion to learn. Mr. White led the program from 1975 to 1996.
Jack Greer Student Development Fund	\$1000	Full-time SIU Automotive major in good standing who demonstrates a positive attitude, exceptional classroom attendance, and passion to learn. Mr. Greer led the program from 1996 to 2010.
L. D. Willey Outstanding Student Award	\$500	Awarded to the outstanding Automotive senior as selected by the Faculty. Based upon attitude toward work; ability to work with peers; motivation to achieve; enthusiasm to learn; class attendance; GPA and Senior standing. Mr. Willey was the father of the program and chaired it from 1953-1975.
