

INTEGRATED PATH TO ARCHITECTURAL LICENSURE (IPAL)

The online IPAL Master of Architecture program is designed for architecture professionals seeking an accredited professional degree and Licensure that qualifies for National Council of Architectural Registration Boards (NCARB) certification. It requires a Bachelor of Science in Architectural Studies or its equivalent. If your degree counted as a pre-professional degree in architecture, it is acceptable for application to this program. A minimum grade point average of 2.7 in the last 60 hours of undergraduate work is required. To apply for the online Master of Architecture program, you will need to visit the IPAL Graduate Admissions website and apply to SIU. A PDF portfolio file, 2000 AXP hours, and a statement of intent are required to be submitted to the School of Architecture.
