APPLICATION FOR ART HISTORY ENDOWMENT SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility and requirements:

Art History Endowment Scholarships are intended for incoming students interested in, and continuing students pursuing, an art history major. Incoming students at SIUC are required to take at least two art history courses during their first year as scholarship students. For freshmen these would normally be in the 207A, B, C sequence. All second- and third-year scholarship holders, and all continuing students who are awarded the scholarship after their first 30 earned credit hours at SIUC, must be declared art history majors. Scholarship holders are required to register for at least 12 credit hours per semester.

Application materials for incoming students:

Incoming students must submit a letter of application describing your academic goals and accomplishments, official academic transcripts (for entering freshmen, high school transcript; for transfers, transcripts from all colleges attended prior to transfer to SIUC), copies of ACT or SAT scores, and two confidential letters of recommendation in sealed envelopes. These letters should be from teachers or professors with whom you have had a class. One of those letters may come from either a guidance counselor or employer, if relevant. Letters should be sealed and signed across the back by their authors and included in the packet with the other application materials.

Application materials for continuing students:

Submit a letter of application describing your academic and extracurricular activities over the previous year as well as your academic goals for the upcoming year and a copy of your SIUC academic transcript. Awards to continuing students will be based on academic performance and contribution to the academic life of the university through the Art History Association or other organizations and activities. Renewals will only be offered to students with excellent academic records and demonstrated commitment.
