

Application for Professor Steve Belletire Design Scholarship

Award overview: A onetime award of \$500 to one full-time student from the School of art and Design earning a BFA with a concentration in Communication Design and to one full-time student with a concentration in Industrial Design. Award monies will be directly applied to each selected student's bursar's bill for the semester following the award. Awards will be determined by Design tenure track faculty consensus using overall student performance criteria. *Application deadline is the last Friday in March. Scholarship winners will be announced at the annual Design Days event.*

Basic qualifications: Applicants must be successfully completing 200 and/or 300 level design courses in the spring of the academic year and must indicate their intent to complete their degree at SIU. Applicants must have accrued enough credit hours to be considered being in their 3rd year of design studies. A grade of B or better must be earned for each design course. A winning applicant receiving a lower grade at semester's end will result in the award being made to a runner up applicant as determined by the Design faculty. In addition, each applicant must take at least 12 credit hours per semester during the coming academic year.
